We are excited to share our Emerging Leaders Institute at Glen Lake Camp and Retreat Center designed to develop and equip YOU, the young leaders in the church and community. The Glen Lake Emerging Leaders Institute is a multi-week, immersive leadership development experience, custom-designed to foster and grow emerging leaders. It is our hope and prayer as High School students currently in 11th & 12th grade attend the Emerging Leaders Institute you will grow in your faith, make an impact, and develop as a leader. Our "ELI" participants will apply, interview, attend ELI Weekend, be commissioned, serve in practicum weeks, and then be sent out to serve in your local context.

As campers at Glen Lake Camp and Retreat Center we want to be sure you are aware of this opportunity to grow in the way of leadership while also serving at Glen Lake Camp this summer. We invite you to apply to be a part of this program.

Each participant will be required to submit a pastoral/youth director reference, complete a background check, complete MinistrySafe training, attend ELI Weekend in April 2023, serve at camp during one or more of our practicum weeks, and attend our Pathfinder (High School) week of camp in order to be accepted into the Emerging Leaders Institute. At the Emerging Leaders Institute, coaches will guide you to discover your God-given strengths, reflect on what it means to function in a Christian community, and practice servant leadership while making a difference as counselors to over 1,200 children at Glen Lake Camp.

THE PROCESS

1. APPLY

Apply before the deadline. Apply now and start the process!
Applications are open until March 31st.

2. INTERVIEW

Schedule an interview and submit references.
We will reach out to schedule an interview with you (phone call).

3. ACCEPT

Once accepted into ELI, register your acceptance is required to enter the program.
Participants must accept by April 5, 2023.
Paperwork to be completed prior to arrival at ELI Weekend.

4. GLEN LAKE EMERGING LEADERS INSTITUTE WEEKEND

Discover your natural strengths, learn about servant leadership theory, small group dynamics, and how to cast a vision at ELI Weekend.

5. COMMISSIONING

Be commissioned for a summer of ministry at a special service during ELI Weekend on Sunday, April 23rd, at Glen Lake Camp, at 3:00pm.

6. PRACTICUM WEEKS

Practice servant leadership as a counselor at one or more of our Elementary Camps.
Attend as a camper at High School Camp.

7. FALL LEADERSHIP ROLE

Practice servant leadership at your home church or campus ministry in Fall 2023 through a commitment with your local church.



GLEN LAKE EMERGING LEADERS INSTITUTE (ELI)

The Glen Lake Emerging Leaders Institute is a multi-week, immersive leadership development experience. We want to see high school students grow in their faith, make an impact, and develop as the leaders the world and church needs. Glen Lake Emerging Leaders Institute is specifically designed to be the catalyst encouraging campers in their relationship with Christ, the church, and all people. It **IS NOT** a Bible study, or a Sunday school class, or a passion-packed worship event. It **IS** a guided tour of who God created you to be, how God created you to lead, what it means to be a servant leader, and what it means to live in Christian community.

During the Glen Lake Emerging Leaders Institute, participants focus on discovering their natural strengths followed by learning servant leadership theory, small group dynamics, and how to cast a vision. Highly trained coaches guide current 11th and 12th graders to discover their God-given gifts, reflect on what it means to function as a Christian community, and practice servant leadership while making a difference as camp counselors. During Practicum weeks, participants put to practice what they have learned as volunteer counselors at Glen Lake Trailblazer Camps while continuing to receive guidance from Glen Lake Emerging Leaders Institute coaches.

Be part of a ministry team committed to fostering Christian community and spiritual growth while ministering to children at Glen Lake Camp & Retreat Center.

ELI FAQs

GLEN LAKE CAMP & RETREAT CENTER



We have put together some of the most frequently asked questions when it comes to our Emerging Leaders Institute.

Are ELIs leading cabins by themselves?

No, our ELIs are partnered with one of our Summer Staff (college students) for the specific practicum week of camp.

When do I report to camp for the Practicum week and when do I get picked up/leave camp?

ELIs are asked to arrive on Sunday at 2:00pm, to join our all staff meeting. Our ELIs are free to go at 11:30am on Friday. The rest of the time you are a counselor in a cabin.

Is there a packing list?

Yes, you will be provided with a packing list prior to serving during practicum weeks.

When are the practicum weeks?

Practicum weeks are any of our Trailblazer Camps. ELIs have the option to serve as many of them as they would like, but are required to serve at least one week. Dates: June 18-23, June 25-30, July 16-21, July 23-28.

What does High School week look like for an ELI?

High School week is your week of camp, where you get to be a camper!

When should I apply?

Anytime between now and the deadline, March 31st. We are limited on how many ELIs we can take on in a summer, so best to apply now.

Tell me more about the interview...

After you apply, we will connect with you about scheduling a phone interview. This is a chance for us to hear from you about why you want to serve as an ELI. The interview will last about 30 minutes.

Where do we stay when we are at camp?

ELIs will be in the cabins with staff and campers. An ELI will be there to support and help lead a cabin alongside one of our Summer Staff.

Do I receive training to serve at camp?

Yes, ELI Weekend is designed to be a weekend of training in order to be prepared to lead at camp.
